### Transportation

The SAI of Argentina will provide transport on arrival and departure between the Ministro Pistarini Airport, Jorge Newbery Airpark and the different hotels. Transport to all the social events will also be provided, from the Venue Hotel (Panamericano Hotel). Transport from the other hotels to the Venue Hotel will not be provided.

### Meals

During the meeting (06/11-10/11) lunches and coffee breaks are covered by Argentina's SAI. The breakfast is included in the hotel accommodation rate.

The SAI of Argentina will host the Welcome Reception on 07/11 and the SAI of Estonia will host the Closing Dinner on 10/11.

Vegetarian meals will be available for guests with vegan, halal and kosher diets.

### Environmental Excursion

The SAI of Argentina has planned a program for the Environmental Excursion on the 7th. After the breakfast and accreditation, the excursion group will travel to the Port of Tigre by bus (approximately 15 miles). Thereafter two ships will be boarded in order to sail around the Islands on the Parana River Delta. At noon, "Gato Blanco" Restaurant will be headed to, which is on one of the islands. This will allow the delegates to interact with the nature of the place. After lunch, the group will return to the Port of Tigre, where the buses will be awaiting to return guests back to Buenos Aires.

Delegates should wear casual, comfortable clothes, as well as insect repellent, sunscreen and headwear to protect from the sun.

### Electricity information

Please note that in Argentina, power sockets and plugs may be different from the ones you use in your countries. Argentinean sockets accept plugs Type C (two prong-plug), but most of them carry Type I plugs (grounding pin, and two flat current-carrying pins forming an upside down V-shape). However, in most places, power sockets are modified to accept both plugs (as shown below). Remember that Argentina's electricity voltage is 220V.
