In 2005 she was seconded to the UK Parliament as Deputy Head of the Scrutiny Unit, responsible for providing professional support to select committees.

Most recently, she was appointed as a Specialist Advisor to the Communities and Local Government Parliamentary Select Committee on the local government audit inquiry and is Vice Chair of the Macro Economic Committee for the European Centre of Employers and Enterprises providing Public Services (CEEP).

Throughout her career, Gillian has had extensive experience of working with a full range of public authorities, central government and other agencies to help improve performance and governance arrangements. Up until 2007 she was a non-executive of the Legal Action Group (UK). Gillian has an MBA and began her career as a qualified accountant.
